

# Explosives Safety Clear Zone Briefing

**Policy:** It is Air Force policy consistent with operational requirements to:

- Observe explosives safety practices during all operations (includes war time, preparation for war, armistice, heightened tensions, etc.) that include the use of live explosives.
- Comply with Department of Defense (DoD) and Air Force explosives safety and environmental standards.
- Provide the maximum possible protection to personnel and property, both inside and outside the installation, from the damaging effects of potential accidents involving ammunition and explosives.
- Comply with the cardinal principle for explosives safety. Expose the minimum number of people to the minimum amount of explosives for the minimum amount of time.

The established Explosives Safety Clear Zone, Quantity Distance for Inhabited Buildings from our flight line is **400 feet (see attached map)**. The building you are now entering is within the 400 foot explosives safety clear zone. Although the probability of an explosives incident is extremely low, you must be made aware of the potential danger in the event of an accidental detonation. Damage to building and possible injuries to occupants could be expected. You must also adhere to the following requirements:

- You must receive this briefing IAW the 158FW Commanders Safety Policy letter and understand fully the information provided here.
- When directed to stay clear of the Explosives Safety Clear Zone, you must comply immediately
- When an emergency evacuation is ordered, proceed out the main gate and meet at the Army Aviation Facility for accountability

I understand the procedures for entering the explosive safety clear zone. Parent/ Guardian signature required for students under the age of 18.
